Specific objective
<p>The main aim of the proposed project is the transfer of a teaching methodology well known at international level, FEUERSTEIN METHODOLOGY, to the VET system as a tool to acquire key competences ant to promote a guidance system of young people with learning delays.</p> <p>The specific objective is the improvement of vocational and tutoring competences of Employment Centers Operators and Operators of associations working in the field of disabilities so to promote in the disabled young people the acquisition of key competences useful for their job placement.</p>

The project intends also to develop synergies at territorial level among provinces, training centers and job market organizations with the aim to promote joint actions to achieve the project specific object.
